It's just becoming a neurotic age.

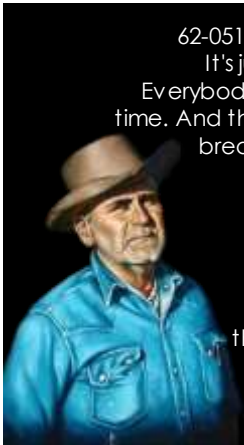
Everybody is all built up. Haven't got no time. And that builds up to a place that it breaks up things. It causes people
