## HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE

## There is no Old Testament Jewish law for adoption.

## Huiothesia Greek (hwee-oth-es-ee'-ah)

Placing of a son.

#### Testamentum Latin

(taist-a-maint-oom)

Adoption through the execution of a will after the passing of the testator.

### Adrogation Latin An adult under their own authority being adopted.

#### Tutela Latin

Often the closest male relative appointed to care for a young male (or woman) heir until he can receive legal rights to his inheritance.

### Epitropos Latin

(e-pee-tro-pos)

Often the closest male relative appointed to care for a young male (or woman) heir until he can receive legal rights to his inheritance.
