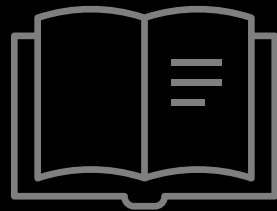

If a person has been married multiple times can they still partake of communion?

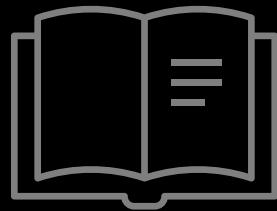

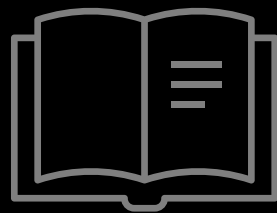

remarriage is adultery.

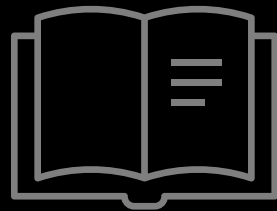
If you married again, what about the
